It may mean the expense of buying a new door and having a cat flap installed by the manufacturer, but cats can live up to 20 years wouldn't it be worth it knowing that they can return home to warmth and safety whenever they want? You won't regret sacrificing other luxuries when you see how often your cats use the catflap, knowing they can come indoors when frightened, unwell or the weather turns bad and you're out or in bed. Catflaps do not increase chances of burglary unless door



keys are left in easy reach (letter boxes are just as risky) and catflaps can now be bought that read the ID chip number of the cat so that other cats are unable to enter. No need for a collar that can often cause injury. Sureflap - Microchip Catflap (<http://www.sureflap.co.uk/>)
